Many members supported community activities throughout the year by volunteering their time and talents.


I hope the new year brings all of us together to worship and celebrate each other. But most importantly, to worship and celebrate our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.



Eagle Fraud Guard has been added to our self-service document searching website. This is a FREE service to citizens who are concerned about potential deception through recordings in Yavapai County.

Proactively monitor and be alerted when a document is registered in a specific individual's name and/or business name in Yavapai County.

An alert email will provide basic information and a link to the document to be reviewed.

- when entering monitored names remember some names are more common than others
- always review the document in an alert to verify you are the individual or business it is referencing
- you must subscribe for this service, change or cancel anytime, call our office if you need any help
