The Season of Lent

"We hope that as Christians we mature and grow and become more and more like Christ. But the church and its wisdom assumes we will fail even after our baptism. The church presumes that life is long and zeal fades not just for some of us but for all. So it has included with it's life a season in which all of us recapture our love for God and his kingdom and cast off those things that so easily entangle us."

Hello, Chino Valley UMC,

The season of Lent is now here! We begin our forty-day countdown to Easter - a forty-day journey with Jesus through his final weeks of ministry, his entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, his death on Good Friday, and then his resurrection on Easter.

If we aren't careful, Lent can be a rather morose time - a time when we focus on all the ways we may have failed to live up to the life that Jesus calls us - failed as disciples, servants, family, and friends. We might be tempted to take on a fast from some of our favorites, or take on a practice like reading the Bible, or praying, not so much out of desire, but out of punishment.

I want to challenge us to try Lent a different way. I am inspired by the quote from Dr. McCaulley above to begin Lent with my eyes set on the right goal - the goal is not to meditate on my failure, the goal is to recapture my love for God - loving Jesus with all my heart, soul, and mind.

If greater love is the purpose, this changes the mission of Lent - it's not dredging up the past to fix it (I probably can't, anyway) - it's realizing that we are here now, and we have forty days to love God like crazy.

So, here comes Lent! I ask you...

How can you love God like crazy for the next forty days?

...Is there anything that if you stopped doing it, would it bring more of God's love to you, and to the world?

...Is there anything you could do that would let you enjoy the love of God more?

If you give these questions some time, I think you'll be ready for a better Lent.

I look forward to loving God like crazy with all of you this month at our church! Sincerely.

News from the Leadership Board Anita MacFadden

The Leadership Board met February 16 and once again covered multiple topics in a short period of time. Here is a synopsis with what we covered:

Leadership Development

For the next several meetings we are reviewing the handout *Wearing Four Hats*, *Understanding the Leadership Board's Roles in SAS (Simplified Accountability Structure)*. At our meeting we covered the general overview and learned the following about the four "hats:"

- The Church Council "Hat" Ensuring mission alignment, strategic vision, and ministry effectiveness
- **The Finance "Hat"** overseeing budgets, stewardship, and long-term financial sustainability
- The Trustees "Hat" managing legal obligations, property stewardship and risk management
- The SPRC "Hat" supporting and holding the pastor and staff accountable while ensuring healthy leadership structures.

Financials

We reviewed the January Financials, noting that the expenses exceeded the income for the month by just over \$2,700.00.

Mission Accountability

We covered two items – new members and Goal #4 Building Ministry Teams.

- 1. On the new member front, we have 8 people who have indicated they would like to become members of our church and help us in furthering our mission to love God and serve the community so that lives are better. New Member Sunday is March 2. I hope you can be there to welcome our new members.
- 2. We have started the process of creating the Building Maintenance Team (BMT). The BMT is the volunteer team who will plan and carry out maintenance and repair tasks at our church, and work together to plan bigger repairs and projects. There was a meeting after church on February 23 led by Pastor Kevin and Team Leader Walter Floyd. Three persons attended with three others indicating interest but unable to attend. Many of you have great knowledge and skills if you can join the team, we will do great work together.

If you are interested in what the Leadership Board is doing ask one of the members or attend one of our meetings. Our next meeting is scheduled for Sunday March 23, 11:30-2:30. All are welcome to attend the open session.
