A Word from Pastor Kevin

Dear Chino Valley UMC,

If you've been able to join us for worship the last few weeks, we've been going through a series called "Rooted" where we are reading through the major moments of the Bible, and seeing that when God meets human persons to change the world, it just so happens that there is a tree standing nearby. This isn't coincidence - the authors of the Bible use the tree to give us clues that something is going to happen when God and people meet that will bring new life to the world.

This is a good moment for us to ask: where do you and God meet? We believe the Holy Spirit is with us, always, but are there particular places where you go to hear or speak with God? Are there places that, when you are in them, help you become aware of God's presence in a special way?

When I was young, I had a hard time praying because God was too "imaginary" - it was hard for me to connect with God without having an actual physical space for it. So, I started praying with two chairs - one that I sat in, and one that I left as a space for God. This was a huge help, and every bench, couch, or open car seat became a place where I could speak with God.

"Chairs" became for me, what "trees" were for Abraham and Moses. I don't always need the chairs now, but, sometimes I still like to use them.

I hope that you have found a way to pray that works for you - a place, an object, a part of the world that seems to make living with God a bit easier. This can be hard for some of us though, so if you need help, let's talk.

I pray, always, that you all find our church to be a good "tree" - a place where you experience the love and presence of Jesus. May our neighbors find this true as well!
