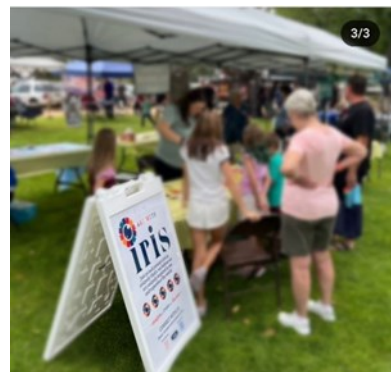

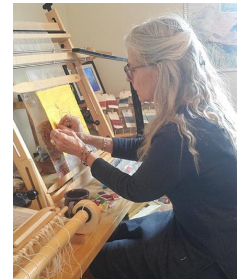
Again, this year Anna Knittle will have the "Root Beer Floats" ice cream social one or two more flavors to bring back some of those memories when things were a bit more simple
