We are currently working to finalize the 2025 budget, with the goal to approve it in December. To help with balancing the budget, we will be applying for Equitable Compensation to help us with an anticipated budget shortfall.

Our Stewardship Campaign runs through the first three Sundays of November. The theme is Time, Talent, Treasure, recognizing that our stewardship is multifaceted Each Sunday we will have a features speaker to share their stewardship story.
